

**SENATE COMMITTEE ON STUDENT DISCIPLINE
REPORT ON ACADEMIC INTEGRITY VIOLATIONS (FY19)**

According to §1-405(d) of the Student Code: "The executive director of the Senate Committee on Student Discipline shall compile an annual report to the Senate on the number and severity of such infractions of academic integrity, without identification of the individuals involved. The report shall be available to the public."

This report reflects all academic integrity infractions reported to the Senate Committee on Student Discipline from July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019. Any cases that were under appeal or still subject to appeal as of June 30, 2019, may not be included.

Also in FY19, trained decision-makers under the authority of the Senate Committee on Student Discipline addressed 74 cases in which students had been found responsible for a second, third, etc. academic integrity infraction. As a result, 63 students were placed on conduct probation, 5 were placed on dismissal held in abeyance status, 3 were dismissed, and 3 were addressed in other ways.
