

## SENATE COMMITTEE ON STUDENT DISCIPLINE REPORT ON ACADEMIC INTEGRITY VIOLATIONS (FY21)

According to §1-405(d) of the Student Code: "The executive director of the Senate Committee on Student Discipline shall compile an annual report to the Senate on the number and severity of such infractions of academic integrity, without identification of the individuals involved. The report shall be available to the public." This report includes all academic integrity infractions reported to the Senate Committee on Student Discipline between July 1, 2020, and June 30, 2021.

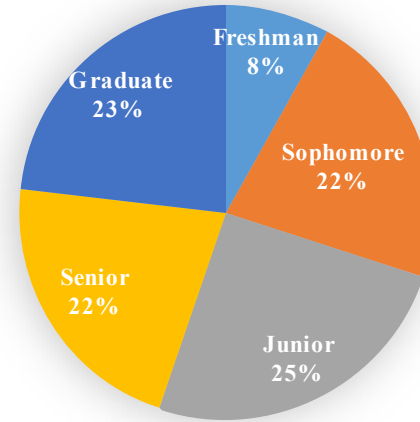
Also in FY21, trained decision-makers under the authority of the Senate Committee on Student Discipline addressed 78 cases in which students had been found responsible for a second, third, etc. academic integrity infraction. As a result, 69 students were placed on conduct probation, 4 students were placed on dismissal held in abeyance status, and 5 were dismissed from the university.

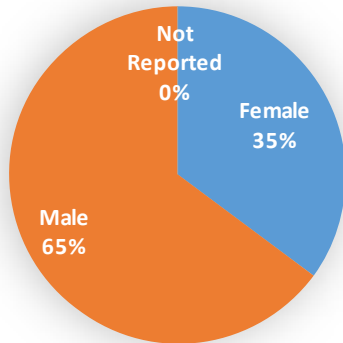
